



Camp Corazon

is a free 3-day, 2-night camp for young people age 7 to Senior in high school who are grieving the death of a loved one. Camp was created to serve bereaved families living outside of Central NM that cannot access CGC services due to distance. Campers enjoy traditional camp activities such as games, bonfires, challenge courses and songs, but also receive the unique opportunity to share feelings and memories with others who have lost a loved one. Camp provides bereaved young people with coping skills that will help them long after Camp Corazon ends.
