The Program



Leadership Sandoval County is an unique program designed to engage emerging and existing leaders and through civic leadership development for the benefit of the Sandoval County region. Through a series of fascinating programs about the various challenges and critical issues that impact the County's diverse community. It is an enriching and active learning experience dedicated to building a nucleus of informed citizens who will assume leadership roles in their companies and the community.

The Commitment

Leadership Sandoval County is offered one full day monthly, September through June. Participants must be dedicated and committed to attending each class as graduation is based on attendance at all class sessions and completion of other course requirements.

The Benefits

Participants in Leadership Sandoval County have an opportunity to refine their personal and public leadership skills, develop diverse contacts and an excellent network. Graduates are provided opportunities for taking an active and effective role in addressing community needs, while gaining a greater commitment to community stewardship.

Curriculum Elements

Monthly sessions focus, not only the topic of the day, but serves to enhance leadership skills, promote camaraderie and build lifetime relationships among participants. Throughout the course, the curriculum encourages participants to examine their leadership styles and strategies, experience team building, networking and be informed of topically relevant issues that impact Sandoval County. Curriculum topics throughout the year include: Criminal Justice; Business & Leadership Ethics; Economic Development; City/County/State Government; Health & Human Services; Education and Tourism.

Additionally, all participants work together on a community-oriented group project that will require meetings outside of the regular class days.



Tuition

Course tuition in May June & July early price \$850 and covers all materials and related expenses. August 1 tuition price is \$1,000.

Interested applicants are encouraged to discuss tuition with your employers as many companies recognize the value and benefits of financially supporting their leadership, community involvement and knowledge.

Selection

Completed applications are due in by July 31st to the Chamber. Each class is limited to forty participants to maximize the personalized experience. Through a competitive application process that includes an interview, class participants are selected by a panel comprised of LSC Alumni, community leaders and business professionals.
