Our Rio Rancho campus is an important part of Intel's global manufacturing and technology development network; today, over 1,200 employees develop and manufacture microprocessor technology that powers data centers and hundreds of millions of smart and connected devices worldwide.

ECONOMIC IMPACT

We provide high-skill, high-paying jobs and also support the economy through our R&D ecosystem spending, sourcing activities, and tax revenue. Since 1980, Intel has invested more than \$15 billion to build high-tech manufacturing capacity in New Mexico. Our preference is to source locally when possible, and over the past five years, we spent more than \$1 billion with state-based organizations. In addition, an independent economic impact study we commissioned found that for every Intel job in the U.S., an additional 13 American jobs are supported.

ENVIRONMENTAL SUSTAINABILITY

We continually strive to improve our operations and minimize our impact on the environment, and our purchases of renewable power and renewable energy certificates cover 100% of our power use in New Mexico. Sustainable water management is also critical to our operations, and in addition to our on-site conservation, we also fund collaborative community-based projects that restore water to the environment.

DIVERSITY AND INCLUSION

Intel believes that in order to shape the future of technology, we must be representative of that future. By bringing together people with a wide range of perspectives, backgrounds, and experiences, we can continue to innovate and solve the world's toughest challenges. In 2018, we reached our goal to achieve full representation of underrepresented minorities and women in our U.S. workforce – and we're more committed than ever to ensuring we have an inclusive culture and diverse supply chain.

SOCIAL IMPACT

Over the last five years, Intel, the Intel Foundation, and Intel employees gave more than \$10.5 million in grants, donations, and in-kind gifts to local New Mexico schools, universities, and non-profits. In addition, last year more than 800 of our employees and retirees generously donated their time, volunteering over 23,100 hours in the community.

TECHNOLOGY INNOVATION

Our Rio Rancho fabrication facility manufactures on both 32nm and 45nm technology. Rio Rancho has also been an important development and manufacturing site for Intel® Silicon Photonics, a new class of high-speed optical connectivity that uses fiber optics instead of copper wires for data communications. Rio Rancho will also be the future site of our Optane™ Technology Development and NAND Pathfinding and Research teams.
